CORE CURRICULUM

This checklist is for first-time freshman admitted to the Eccles School via the Business Scholars Experience program.

MAJOR DECLARATION

When students move into the Eccles School (Upper Division) coursework, they are declared as Intermediate Business. Students will need to complete specified upper-division coursework and any prerequisites for their chosen major and then submit an online application to their major. TRANSFER CREDIT

HONORS DEGREE

Honors courses typically end in “1” and require a minimum GPA for enrollment and are reserved for Honors and Business Scholars Experience students. Students seeking an HBA (Honors Bachelor of Arts) or HBS (Honors Bachelor of Science) from the Eccles School must complete the Honors College’s requirements and their major’s honors requirements.
