CORE CURRICULUM for transfer students from Salt Lake Community College (SLCC) with an AS in business

This checklist is for students who have an Associate of Business degree from Salt Lake Community College. Students should apply for admission to the Eccles School (Upper Division) when they are taking their final business prerequisite courses by submitting an [online application](#). MAJOR DECLARATION

When students are admitted to the Eccles School (Upper Division), they are declared as Intermediate Business. Students will need to complete specified upper-division coursework and any prerequisites for their chosen major and then submit an online application to their major. TRANSFER CREDIT

Admission into the Eccles School is contingent upon full completion of pre-requisite courses. All transfer courses are subject to official approval through the Transfer Equivalency Guide. For more info, please visit [Eccles.Link/transferguide](#).

HONORS DEGREE

Honors courses typically end in “1” and require a minimum GPA for enrollment and are reserved for Honors and Business Scholars Experience students. Students seeking an HBA (Honors Bachelor of Arts) or HBS (Honors Bachelor of Science) from the Eccles School must complete the Honors College’s requirements and their major’s honors requirements.

Students not pursuing ACCTG are encouraged to take MGT 39XX this semester.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS: **PRIOR TO APPLYING TO MAJOR**

These classes are flexible between semesters, but all must be completed prior to admission to a specialized major area. Students who are full-time should plan to complete these during junior year alongside the courses on page 3. Students who are part-time should consult their academic advisor to develop a plan.
